

Francesco Fonassi (b. 1986, Italy)

Sonic artist, independent researcher, musician, sound designer/producer active since 2006 in the field of sound-based performance, transmission/transmedial art, experimental music. His work, developed through actions, recordings, environmental configurations, radio broadcasts, listening sessions, sculptural prototypes, installations and audiovisual / sensory space design, has been presented in institutions, museums, festivals and independent spaces in Europe, Asia and the United States.

Among the international institutions that have supported and produced his work are: EMS - Elektronik Musik Studios (Stockholm, SVE); Palais de Tokyo (Paris, FR); MAXXI, MACRO, Auditorium Parco della Musica, Quadriennale (Rome, I); InterArtCenter (Malmö, SVE); OMI Foundation (NY, USA); Corge/Kohjii International (New Delhi, IND); Centrale FIES (Dro, I); Emily Harvey Foundation (NY, USA); CoCA (Torun, PL).

As a musician he has taken part in festivals including LUUFF (Lausanne, 2019), Transmissions Festival (Ravenna, 2022); Heart of Noise (Innsbruck, 2023); Braille Satellite (Vilnius, 2019); Cosmic Gathering (Chemnitz, 2022), Troglobatem Festival (Stuttgart, 2019); Club Cocoon (Brussels, 2022), he has played in numerous European independent venues and released on labels such as Canti Magnetici, Villa Recordings, Setola Di Maiale. Between 2016 and 2020 he created soundtracks for experimental films and CGI videos by the artist Carola Bonfili, produced by foundations and contemporary art museums including Center d'Art Contemporain, Geneva (CH) and Fondazione Baruchello, Rome (I). He is part of the avant-folk music duo Interlingua (with singer and percussionist Francesco Venturi), of the electronic trio Chorus Abstracta (with Simone and Michele Bornati), of the duo with producer Marta Salogni and performs in solo as Quasai. He has collaborated with artists, musicians and researchers including the singer Letizia Fiorenza Sautter, the sound artist Luca Garino, the performer Syowia Kyambi, the voice artist Ines Marita, the composer Alvin Curran, the physicist Michele Ducceschi, the linguist and translator Giulia Galvan , the visual artist Karin Ferrari, the psychologist Saori D'Alessandro, the playwright Mladen Alexiev.

Since 2018 he has been co-founder and co-artistic director of Spettro (www.spettro.info), an independent venue/research sound lab/radio platform/club in Brescia (I), part of a European circuit of musicians and sound artists outside the mainstream market. Since 2015 he co-manages the independent label Villa Recordings.
